

Papyrus no: A 1230

Date: 3rd century A.H./9th century A.D.

Physical description: 13 cm. x 9.5 cm. Small *lacuna* in the middle. Writing on both sides. Recto, written in black ink, 4 lines. Verso, written in black ink, 5 lines. The papyrus piece was cut from a larger sheet. The script on the recto is written at right angles to the fibres and at right angles to the text on the verso. The script on the verso, written at right angles to the fibres, is the remainder of the text from the original sheet.

Text:

RECTO

Script

The tail of final *yā'* extends to the right. *Scriptio defectiva* of long *ā* in دينار (dināran) and ثمنية (tamāniya).

Content

Docket stating that the contents of something is 47 and 3/4 dīnārs: في هذه ... ثمنية واربعين دينرا غير الربع

VERSO

Script

Final *'alif* extends below the connecting stroke.

Content

Fragment of a letter. Top and left side are missing. Closes with the *taṣliya*.
