

Cambridge University Libraries Covid-19 Addendum to the Code of Conduct

Our Code of Conduct sets out what you can expect from our services and how we support you. The principles stated in this document and Addendum remain valid during the Covid-19 pandemic and during the ongoing recovery period.

Please note that Covid-secure protocols are in place and apply to all library visitors, including readers. The protocols have been agreed with the University's Safety Office as appropriate for staff and library visitors on site on library premises.

- Social distancing at 1m+ (2m wherever possible)
- Face coverings must be worn on library premises unless exempt
- Regular hygiene measures, such as hand-washing and sanitiser

Bookings to use on-site facilities are also in place to help maintain safe occupancy levels and comply with Track and Trace requirements.

In agreement with the University, these **protocols remain in place beyond 19 July 2021** and are expected behaviours of library staff and library visitors, including readers.

Should you feel ill or suspect you may be ill, please do not come to the Libraries.

If in doubt, we ask you to err on the side of caution and ask you to contact us so we can cancel any bookings you have made.

We reserve the right to ask you to leave or refuse you entry if we suspect you are displaying symptoms or if you refuse to comply with the Covid-secure protocols in place at our library sites.
