¹ The baseline for Ibn Mājīd's calendar is 1488 CE. In 1488 CE, the difference between the Julian and Gregorian calendars was 9 days [Of course the Gregorian Calendar didn't exist then]. So if the 1st day of the year in Ibn Mājīd's system corresponds to November 14 in the Gregorian calendar, then in the Julian calendar this would be November 5, 1488.

² The lunar mansion "Avihi" (corresponding to Sa'd al-Ḍābiḥ) is not included in the official modern Maldivian calendar. However, since its name survives in both Dhivehi and Arabic, it was likely part of the system during Ibn Majid's time (around 1488). The Maldivians may have later removed it to adjust their calendar to account for the growing discrepancy between the Persian year count and Western calendars.
