The compiler appears to have worked at least partly from the Catalogue of 1574 (CUA, CUR, 31.1(5)), rearranging entries by subject and distinguishing (not always consistently) between manuscripts and printed books. Oates and Pink note discrepancies between the two lists; the presence of ten items in Caius that are not in the Catalogue of 1574 (two of which may be a duplicate entry; seven may be traced in the Catalogue of 1556-57 and one in the Catalogue of 1573). They also note twelve items in the Catalogue of 1574 that do not appear in Caius's list. For further details, see:
